1. It would be helpful to see the rubric for the portfolio and a description of what is included in the document.
2. It would be helpful to see the embedded assessments and their rubrics (D2L assessment tool, survey of graduates, and example of qualitative data from the Program Advisory Council).
3. Student Learning Outcomes appear to be measurable only after the graduate has left the program and begun work. You may consider revising them so that they are phrased in terms of “has ability to...”
4. How will you list the learning outcomes? Just the main ones?
5. Report describes actions that have taken place, but doesn't seem to suggest future changes. Also, it would be helpful to assess whether changes have worked.
6. We noted several typographical errors in the report.

We don't need to see anything more from you this year, but we would like to see your report again next year.
