Fargo Film Festival Internship Application Form

The Department of Film Studies, MSUM, recommends an intern to the Fargo Film Festival annually. This internship is intended to provide students an opportunity to develop their programming, curating, and writing interests as part of their academic and professional development.

Eligibility Requirements: The internship is open to MSUM Film Studies **MAJORS** who have **junior or senior status with a minimum 3.0 GPA**. Candidates eligible for graduation in December 2010 or later may apply. Proof of registration is required.

Application Materials Should Include:

- a. A Current Resume.
- b. A brief (no more than 150 words) summary of the Fargo Film Festival.
- c. Given your answer to **(b)** above, provide a one-page (max) proposal of what you see as possible areas of collaboration between the Film Studies Department and the Fargo Film Festival.
- d. How do you see yourself functioning to meet the goals of this collaboration?
