

**In order to obtain a MN driver's license you must be able to verify your identity. You must provide the Driver and Vehicle Services' office with a primary document and a secondary document.**

- Your Passport, I94, and I20 all are counted as one primary document. Bring these documents with you.
  
- You must also provide what is considered a secondary document. A Social Security Card is considered a valid secondary document; however, if you do not have a Social Security Card the DMV has indicated that students can submit a Certified Post-Secondary transcript with your legal name and birth date. Because no Post-Secondary transcript is going to have your birth date listed on it (due to privacy laws here in Minnesota), you will be able to provide the following as a valid substitute:
  - An official transcript with your legal name showing your enrollment at Minnesota State University, Moorhead. A certified letter from the International Programs Office verifying your Birth Date.

**Process to obtain a Driver's License:**

- 1. Stop by the Records Office and order an official transcript that show's your current enrollment at MSUM. Make sure you request for them to include your current semester listed on the transcript.**
  
- 2. Stop by the International Programs Office to obtain a certified letter that verifies your birth date.**
  
- 3. Bring the following down to the Driver and Vehicle Services:**
  - a. Passport**
  - b. I-20**
  - c. I-94**
  - d. Official Transcript**
  - e. Certified Letter verifying your birth date.**
