

**Paralegal**  **Course Outlines**

- TITLE:** Internship  
(PARA 469)
- OBJECTIVES:**
1. To work under the supervision of a licensed attorney and with others in a law office or agency setting.
  2. To apply the knowledge and skills learned in the classroom, and to develop new skills by being involved in actual cases and projects.
  3. To provide the student with important contact with the legal community which may lead to career opportunities.
- CREDITS:** Minimum of 4 and maximum of 12 semester credits. One credit equals 40 hours of work at the internship site.
- INSTRUCTION:** Hands-on experience; delegation, supervision, and critique by supervising attorneys.
- EVALUATION:** Weekly time and activity sheets; on-site visits; final paper by the student; written evaluation by the supervising attorney
