

Airplane Crash

Minnesota State University Moorhead is in a direct landing path for Fargo Hector International Airport. In the event that an aircraft crashes on campus, take the following action:

1. Take cover under tables, desks and other objects that will give some protection against glass or debris.
2. Call 9-911 to advise them of the situation, provide them with your name and describe the location and nature of the emergency. Stay on the line until the dispatcher tells you to hang up.
3. Contact Campus Security (2449) and advise them of the incident.
4. Activate the building fire alarm.
5. Walk quickly to the nearest exit and ask others to do the same.
6. Do not use elevators in case of fire. Those unable to use the stairs should move to the nearest stairwell or designated refuge area. Rescue personnel should be informed of any persons remaining in the building.
7. Move to a clear area at least 500 feet away from the effected area. Keep streets and walkways clear for emergency vehicles and crews.
8. Assist Emergency crews upon request.
9. Do not return to an evacuated building until emergency service personnel signal the all clear.

An Emergency Response Center may be setup near the disaster site. Keep clear of this center unless you have official business.
