- A.** Contact Campus Security (477-2449), Counseling & Personal Growth Center (477-2835/2081) or the Office of Student Affairs (477-2171). Make appropriate contact and referrals for any of the following crisis situations:
- Alcohol and other drug use emergencies
 - Assault (aggravated; with significant personal injuries)
 - Death of a student, friend, or family member (off-campus loss of life)
 - Demonstration (presenting potential danger)/Riot
 - Discipline issue(s)
 - Disruptive behavior in the classroom
 - Mental health/behavioral incidents or concerns
 - Physical injury (accidental/intentional)
 - Sexual assault
 - Threats to public welfare

Note: Immediately contact proper authorities (i.e., police, ambulance, fire department) by calling 9-911 anytime a personal injury has been sustained, where a life-threatening situation may exist and/or a crime has been or is about to be committed. Other off and on-campus authorities and services may be contacted as time and opportunity permit.
