WHEREAS, Dr. Genevieve N. King joined the faculty of Moorhead State (Teachers) College in 1947; was for many years chairman, first of the Science Department and later of the Division of Science and Mathematics; has been teacher and advisor to thousands of students, many of whom have become professional scientists; has served the larger college in many ways, most notably in the development of the general studies program and, for many terms, as a member of the Faculty Senate; and has touched the lives of her colleagues and students not only professionally but personally, and

WHEREAS, the Building Names Committee, the Faculty Senate and the President of Moorhead State College have recommended that the biology classroom building be named in her honor,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the biology classroom building be named King Biology Hall.
