## American Rescue Plan (ARP) HEERF III Student Emergency Grants Spending Plan:

Minnesota State University Moorhead (MSUM) received \$5,187,282 in total for the student emergency award allocation. Based on system guidance, our proposed utilization is:

HEERF III Immediate Disbursements in block grants: \$4,927,918 (95\%)
HEERF III Application Requests:
259,364 (5\%)
\$5,187,282 (100\%)
Block grants will be distributed to students based on the guidance of prioritizing domestic undergraduate students with exceptional need. Funds will be disbursed after system approval, with the plan for early October.

International students, along with higher need students, may apply through the Student Emergency Assistance Fund (SEAF) application process for ARP HEERF III funding. MSUM will notify students of the availability and process through various social media channels, along with the student email listserve.

Determining exceptional need: MSUM used their Net Price Calculatur to determine an EFC that approximated the IRS salary cap of $\$ 160,000$ for receiving federal stimulus funds. The EFC used is $\$ 30,000$.

Domestic undergraduate and graduate students with an EFC of up to $\$ 30,000$ will be awarded using the following table that takes into consideration EFC and credit load:
