- 2. Technical exercises and drills (comping chord patterns; major, minor and Blues scales).
- 3. Blues.
- 4. Analysis of basic jazz chord progressions.
- 5. Beginning level improvisation (right hand).
- 6. Play and memorize assigned jazz standards appropriate for 100-level study.

- 1. Students taking this course will develop the following skills as appropriate for 100-level study:
 - 1. Read and play assigned, level I, standard lead sheets (melody plus chord symbols)
 - 2. Basic guide tones for chord symbols (either hand)

 - 4. Ability to play: ii7 V7 Imaj7 and ii7(b5) V7(b9) i7 in all keys
 - 5. Basic ability to improvise right hand in assigned, level 1, standard tunes
