### D. LEARNING OUTCOMES (General)

1. Evaluation of students counseling performance throughout the practicum, including documentation of a formal evaluation after the student completes the practicum.
2. Students will earn at least 50 clock hours of direct service with actual clients that contributes to the development of counseling skills.
3. Students will have an average of 1 ½ hours per week of group supervision that is provided on a regular scheduled throughout the practicum by a program faculty member or a student supervisor.
4. Students will have weekly interaction that averages one hour per week of individual and/or triadic supervision throughout the practicum by a program faculty member, a student supervisor, or site supervisors who is working in bi-weekly consultation with a program faculty member in accordance with the supervision contract.
5. Students will learn the development of program-appropriate audio/video recordings for use in supervision or live supervision of the students interactions with clients
