- 5. Register for class(es).** Visit www.mnstate.edu, click current students, and click eServices from the left navigation. Use your username and password to log in and register for classes.

Admission Notes...

As a non-degree seeking student, no transcripts are required unless requested later to establish eligibility.

Non-degree seeking students are not eligible for financial aid and are not assigned an advisor. If you plan to seek a degree from MSU Moorhead, you will need to complete the full application for admission and provide official transcripts from ALL schools attended (high school and college). Another application fee will not be required.
