



Minnesota State University Moorhead BS in Nursing Pre-Requisite Advising Plan

Admission is competitive; 32 students will be admitted for nursing program start for each term start (summer and fall). Enrollment in Nursing is continuous through summer semesters. Admission criteria may change for upcoming nursing application terms & program starts. Changes will be communicated on the program webpage at www.mnstate.edu/bs-nursing

- 1) The **FOUR** courses in the Semester One plan must be completed **prior to the application deadline** with a C- or better and a **2.75 GPA** across these four courses. These four courses will be used to evaluate for admission to the program:

Complete the TEAS Exam: proficiency score = 58.7%.		

- 2) The **FOUR** courses in Semester Two of the program plan must be completed with a C- or better **before starting** the nursing program. Students must have at least a **2.75 GPA** across the semester 1 and semester 2 courses.
