
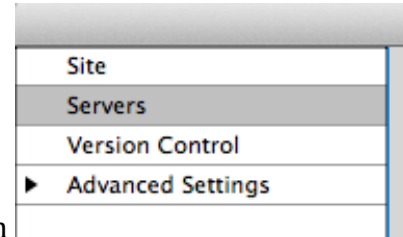


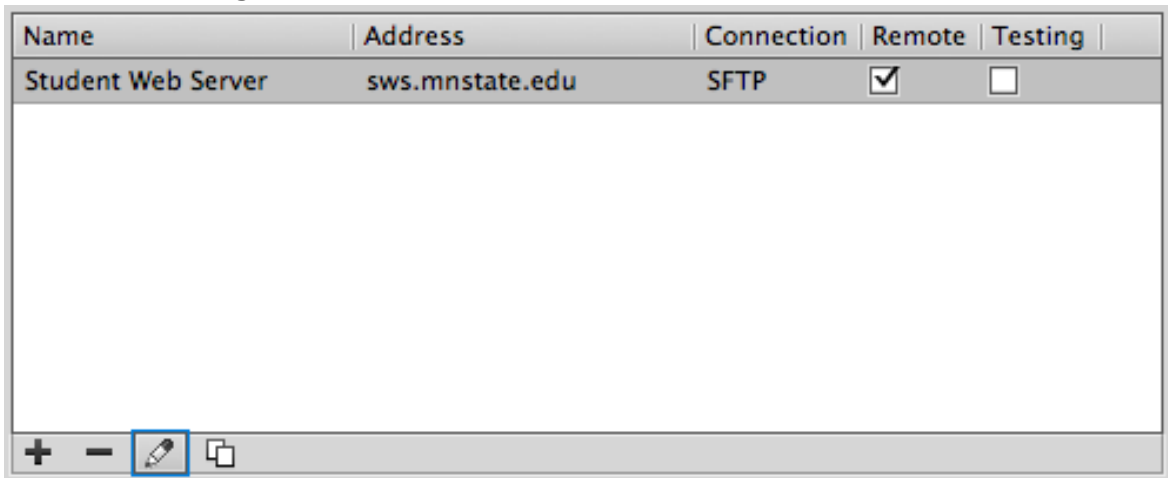
Accessing your folder on the Student Web Server Using Dreamweaver CS6



Editing an Existing Site

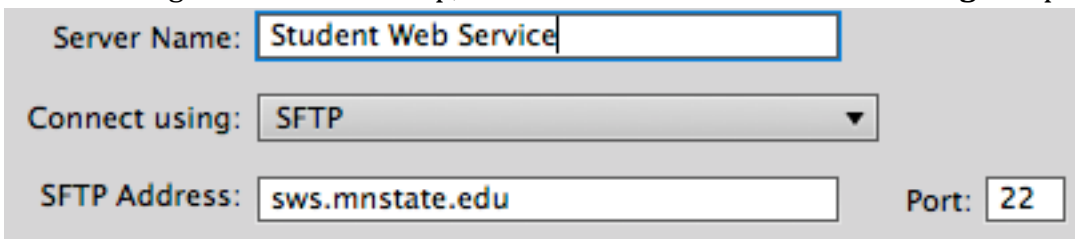
1. Open **Dreamweaver**
2. At the top, select **Site** and then **Manage Sites**
3. Select your site that you want to modify and click the pencil icon 



4. In the dialog box that appears, select **Servers** in the left column
5. Select the existing connection to the Student Web Server

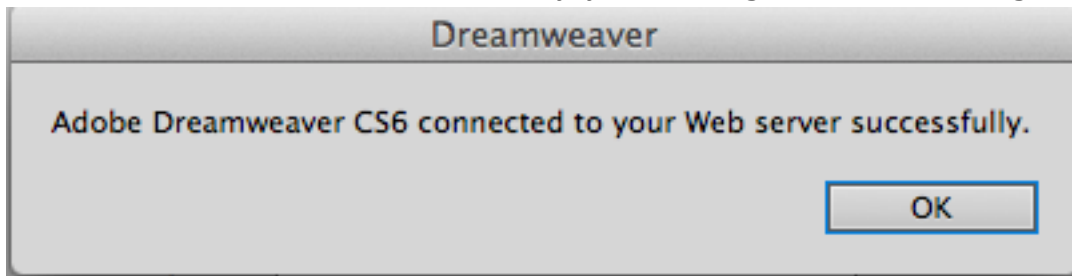


6. Click the pencil icon  to edit the server or the plus icon  to add a new one
7. In the settings box that comes up, select **SFTP** from the “**Connect using**” drop down menu



8. Enter the **URL** as <https://sws.mnstate.edu>
9. Your **username** and **password** for the server are the same as your DragonNet credentials. You may choose to have Dreamweaver save your password.

10. Click the **Test** button. If all is set correctly, you should get a success message



11. Enter **public_html/** as your root directory.

12. Enter the **Web URL** as <http://sws.mnstate.edu/username> where username is replaced by your DragonNet username

13. Click **Save** to save the new server settings

14. Click **Save** to save the site settings

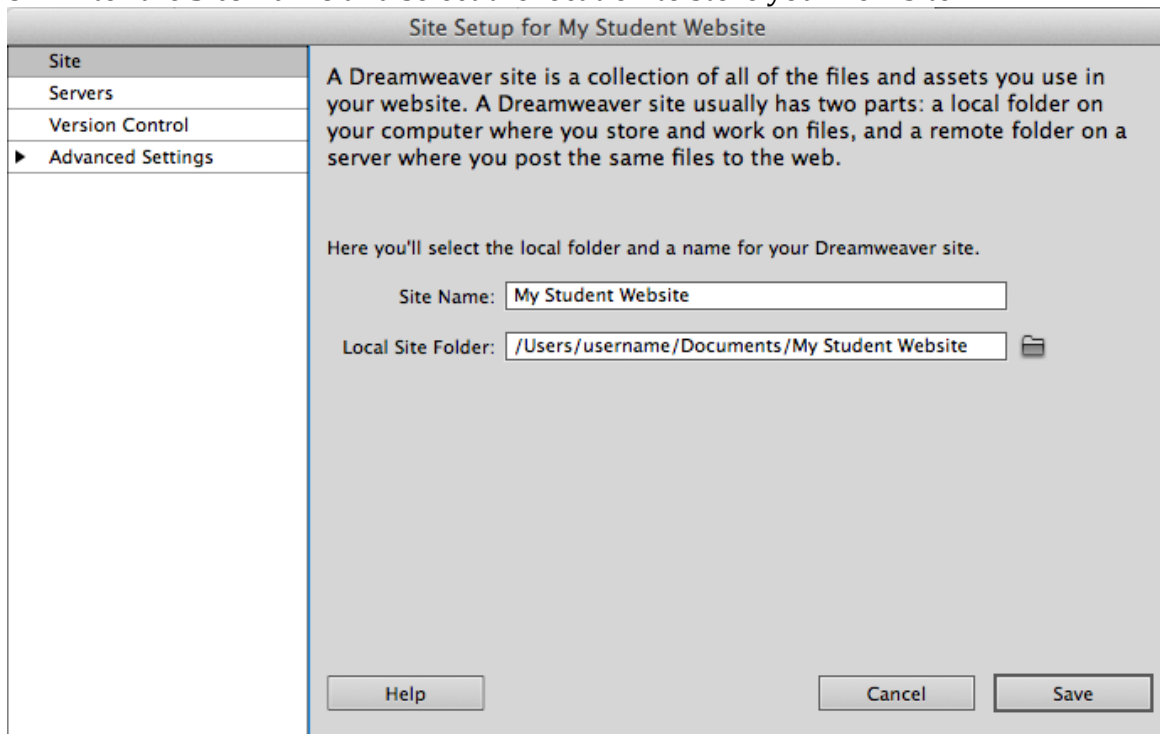
15. Click **Done** to close the site manager

Creating a New Site

1. Open **Dreamweaver**

2. At the top, select **Site** and then **New Site**

3. Enter the **Site Name** and select the location to store your new site



4. Click **Servers** from the column on the left

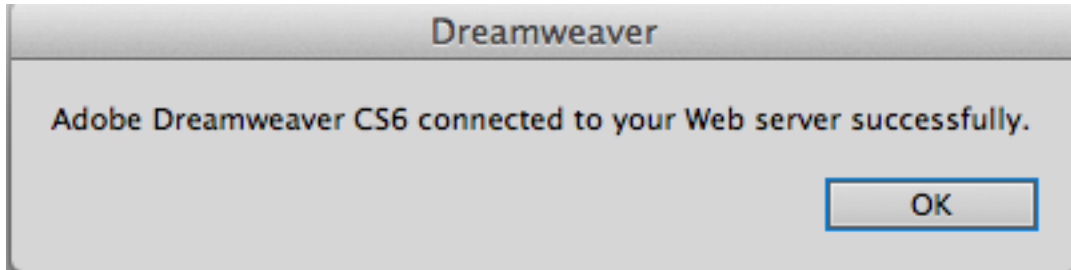
5. Select the plus button **+** to add a new server

6. In the **Server Name** enter the "Student Web Server"

7. In the settings box that comes up, select **SFTP** from the "**Connect using**" drop down menu

8. Enter the **SFTP Address** as <https://sws.mnstate.edu>
9. Your **username** and **password** for the server are the same as your DragonNet credentials and should stay the same from the old server to the new server. You may choose to have Dreamweaver save your password.

11. Enter **public_html/** as your root directory.
12. Enter the **Web URL** as <http://sws.mnstate.edu/username> where username is replaced by your DragonNet username
13. Click **Save** to save the server settings
14. Click **Save** to save the new site
