

I want to use a Non-MSUM ("External Provider") study abroad program. What do I do?

- ◆ Select a program after discussion with your advisor and Office of Study Abroad (see reverse).
- ◆ Apply directly to the program you choose, according to the deadlines listed on their web site/literature.
- ◆ Once accepted, bring a copy of your acceptance letter to the Office of Study Abroad.
- ◆ Request a Non-MSUM program packet and return to the Office of Study Abroad when completed.

(Note: you **must** complete this packet in order to be eligible to study abroad, be registered for courses, and receive financial aid.)

- ◆ Do you need an ISIC card?
- ◆ Do you need a visa for the country you're studying in?
- ◆ Do you have a valid passport?
- ◆ All students must be in good academic standing and good conduct standing in order to be eligible to study abroad.
