

## How do I take part in an MSUM short-term faculty-led program?

- **Review available programs on the MSUM Study Abroad web site: [www.mnstate.edu/studyabroad/facultyled](http://www.mnstate.edu/studyabroad/facultyled)**

The selection changes annually so check the list each fall semester.

- **Attend an information session:**

Contact the faculty leader and attend sessions for answers to your questions about course content, cost, and the features of the destination country.

- **Turn in application form (attach fee and all required paperwork):**

The faculty leader will provide you with forms and admission requirements (such as GPA and relevant major), and notify you of application deadlines.

- **Attend all pre-departure meetings:**

Your syllabus will reflect course expectations. Pre-departure meetings will include part of the course content, and prepare you for your experience abroad.

- **Go abroad!:**

Fully participate in all aspects of your course while away. Be mindful of your role as not only a student, but a representative of MSUM and an informal ambassador of our country.

- **Plan for a thoughtful return:**

Your professor will have follow-up, reflective homework for you to complete after you return. Think about the gains you've made while abroad, and visit the Career Development Center for tips on how to incorporate this course into your resume', and be ready to answer questions about it in future job interviews.
